Town of Haymarket Parade Participation Agreement

The goal of the Town of Haymarket Parade is to provide an annual celebration that Builds community spirit and promotes Haymarket as an inclusive and friendly community. To do that, the Parade must be both entertaining and safe for all participants and spectators, but especially children. As a result, it is necessary to have basic rules that govern the event, which the Town will enforce as set out below.

All Parade Unit Applications must include this agreement, signed by an authorized group leader.

Please carefully read the rules and regulations.

- 1. The Town of Haymarket has the right to establish the Parade theme, determine the number of entries, select and reject participants at its sole discretion, and control Parade operations on the day of the event. All participants must be approved in advance by the Town and participate through an approval unit. All participants will promptly and completely follow the direction of the Town's Parade Coordinator.
- 2. All entries must represent a business or an organized community, neighborhood or other non-profit group. Each Parade Unit must be properly identified by a sign or banner carried by a walker or mounted on the front of a vehicle.
- 3. The Parade is primarily to be viewed by children. All entries must be kid-friendly and contribute to the overall theme of the Parade. No profanity, obscenity, or smoking will be permitted in the Parade at any time.
- 4. Parade entries must be costumed/designed in a way that is appropriate to the "Spook-tacular" theme of the 2021 Parade. All participants in a Unit must contribute to the theme. All vehicles in the parade must be decorated. Units whose participants have existing uniforms (such as Scouts, fire/rescue, bands or veterans) may march in these uniforms. Appropriate Unit themes include but not limited to Halloween costumes, spooky characters, pumpkins, and other fall related spooky items.
- 5. For safety reasons, Parade participants MAY NOT THROW ANY ITEM during the Parade including, but not limited to balloons, candy, flowers, toothbrushes, leaflets or promotional items. Distribution may only be hand-to-hand.
- 6. All Units are required to maintain a forward motion at a Parade pace. Performances must not impede the flow of following Units in the Parade.
- 7. Vehicles that are not an integral part of carrying out a Unit's Parade theme may not accompany the Unit along the Parade route. Adults carrying other items for participants must walk behind spectators along the route. All walkers must be in uniform or dressed to match the theme of the Unit and the theme of the Parade.
- 8. NO ADDITIONAL equipment or vehicles will be accepted the day of the event.

All participants must in line and ready by 9:30AM.

- 9. Drivers must operate equipment and vehicles in a safe, courteous, and responsible manner. **Semi trucks are NOT PERMITTED in the parade.**
- 10. Political Parade participants are limited to current local, county and state elected officials and candidates who have filed the statement of qualification required by state law. As with all other Units, the costumes and decorations of a political participant must follow the theme of the Parade and be entertaining to the total audience, which includes children.
- 11. Failure to comply with these rules will result in disqualification of the sponsor, responsible person, and/or participants from future parades. If a Parade participant's behavior presents a safety risk, the Town may immediately eject that participant from the Parade. Adult participants in the Parade are responsible for the behavior of children in their Unit and the Town will require an adult participant to accompany any child ejected from the parade.
