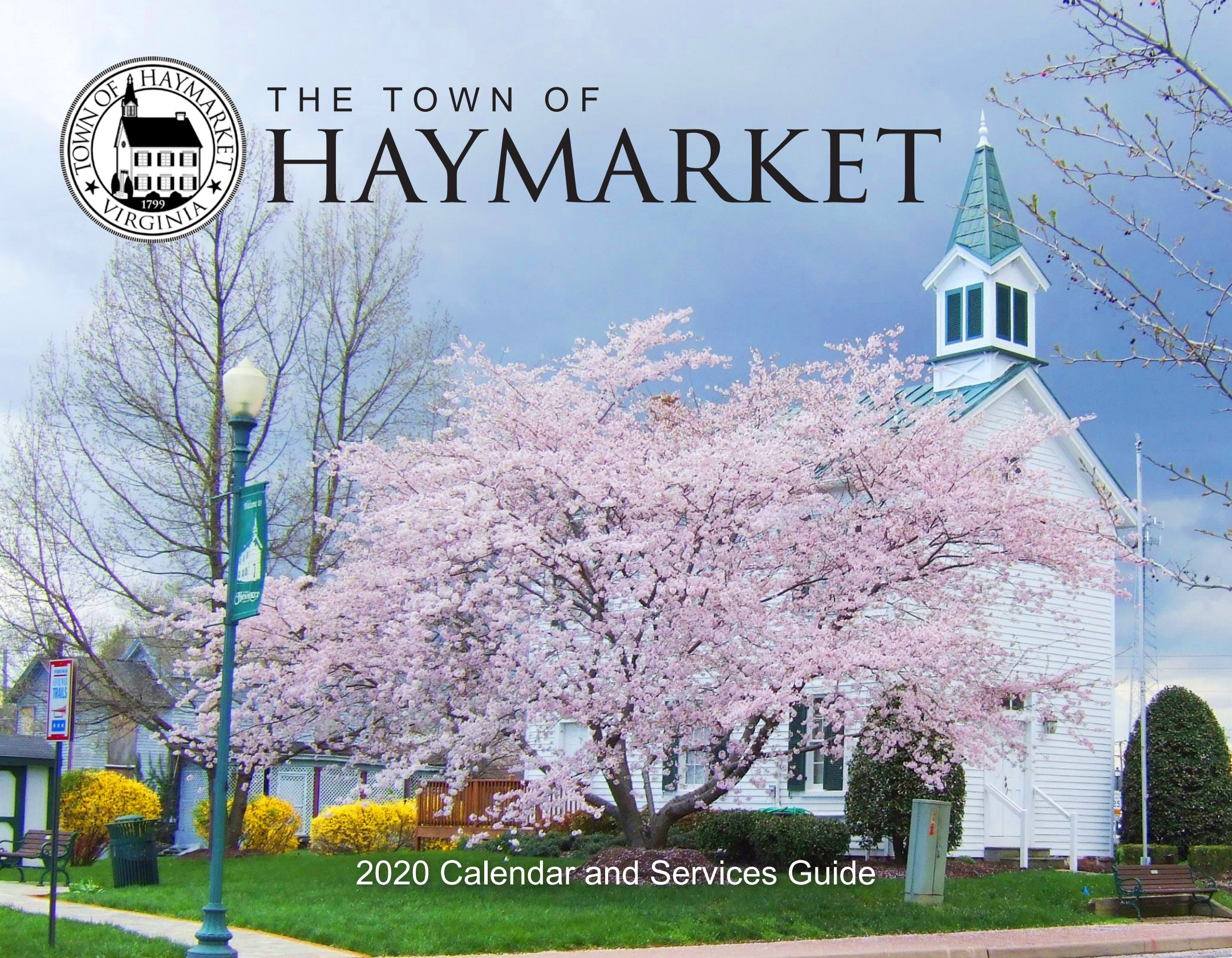

David Leake serves as Mayor of the Town of Haymarket. The Mayor is the Chief Executive Officer of the town and presides over Town Council meetings. His power and authority are derived from the Town Charter and the general laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia. By his signature, the Mayor authenticates any document or instrument required by the Council.

The duties of the seven-member Town Council include establishing town government policy, acting upon local resolutions and ordinances, setting tax rates, approving the annual town budget, appointing members to boards and commissions and providing policy guidance to the town manager.

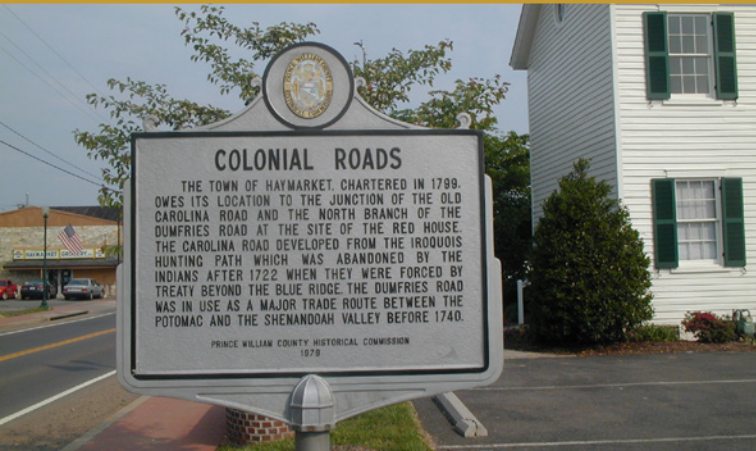
All meetings begin at 7pm and are open to the public. Citizens are encouraged to attend. Meetings are held in the Town Hall located at 15000 Washington Street, Suite 100 the first Monday of each month and can be viewed live at townofhaymarket.org.

The Planning Commission is a seven-member body appointed by the Town Council, with each member serving four-year terms. The Town of Haymarket Commission is responsible for review of zoning and land use matters and is supported by the Town Planner, Emily Lockhart. The Planning Commission reviews applications submitted for changes to zoning districts, special use permits, zoning ordinance and comprehensive plan amendments, and other land use and zoning matters.

The Commission meets the third Monday of each Month at 7:00 pm at Town Hall, 15000 Washington Street, Suite 100.

In 1994, the Haymarket Town Council placed the entire Town under a Historic District Zoning Ordinance. A “Historic District” is an overlay zoning which imparts additional protection specific to historic structures and the historic resources of the Town, in addition to underlying zoning requirements required by the Town’s Zoning Ordinance. The adoption of a local historic district and ordinances to protect historic resources is authorized by Sec. 15.2.2306, et. Seq, of the Virginia Code, which recognizes the importance of preserving a local jurisdiction’s historic heritage. A local property does not have to be listed in either a state or national register in order to be designated historic on the local level. The Town Code designates “historic” as all structures that are 50 years old or older. When the Town Council adopted the Historic District in 1994 the Haymarket Architectural Review Board (ARB) was established. The purpose of the ARB is to promote the general welfare, through the preservation and protection of historic places and areas of historic interest, all buildings within the Old and Historic Town of Haymarket which are 50 years old or older are designated historic buildings. No historic building may be demolished, in whole or in part, nor may any architectural features of such buildings which are subject to public view from a public street be altered without prior application to the Architectural Review Board. The board shall consist of up to seven members, but not fewer than five, appointed by the Town Council, and shall be legal residents of the Town. The term of office of the members shall be for three years, except that the term of the Council member and Planning Commission member shall correspond to their official tenure of office.

The Architectural Review Board (ARB) meets the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall, 15000 Washington Street, Suite 100.

CORE VALUES

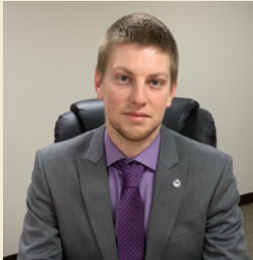
- **Integrity** - We conduct ourselves with uncompromising honesty, honor, ethics, and nobility in all situations and relationships.

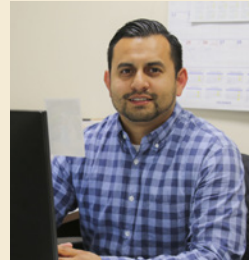

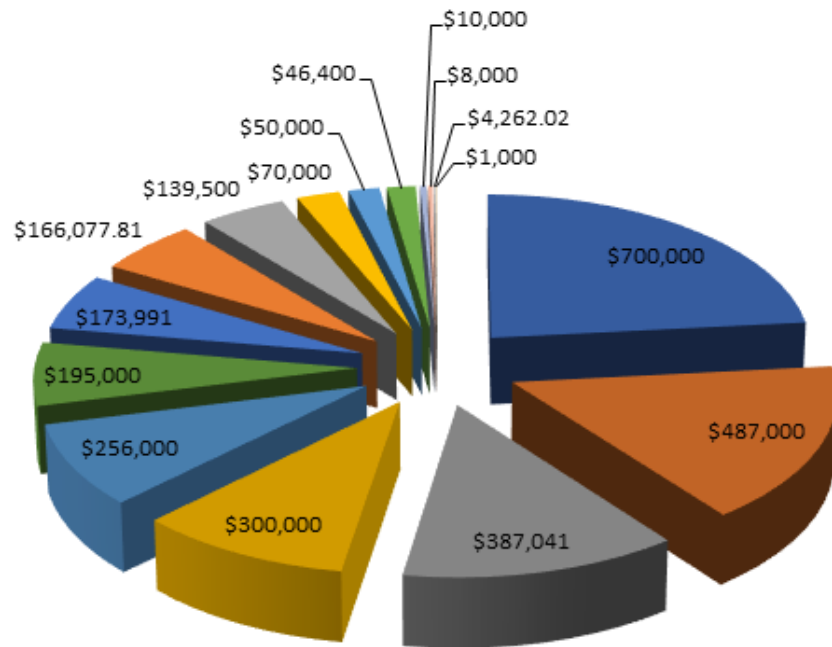

The Town Administrative Assistant provides administrative support to ensure efficient operation of the town. Supports the town staff with tasks related to organization, communication, events and social media.

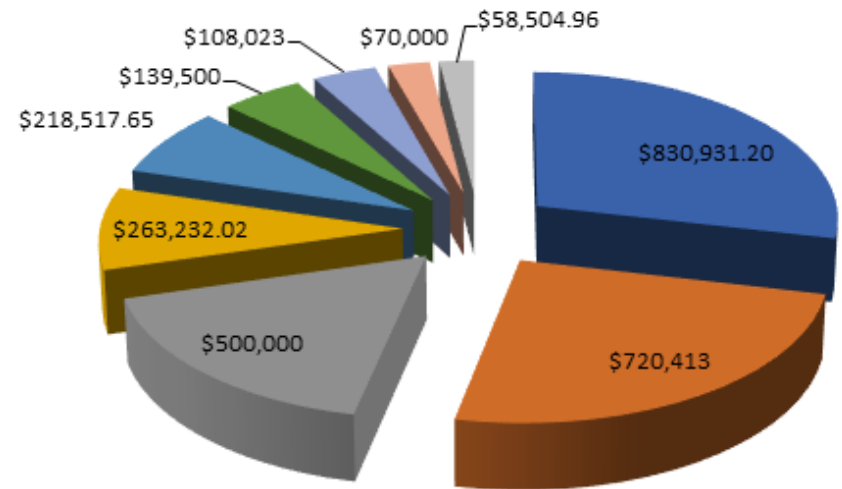
