JULY 20, 1989-7:30 p.m.

A Special Called For Meeting was called to order on July 20, 1989, at 7:30 p.m.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the meeting was to approve or disapprove two Business Licenses; one was for WOLFE INDUSTRIAL AUCTIONS, INC. to hold a one day auction on July 21, at the corner of Rt. 15 & 55. Haymarket, Va. 22069. and the other one was for Jim Underwood operating as Underwood's Deli, to sell food at the auction for one day only.

PRESENT:

Present at the meeting was Mayor Terri Freeborn, Council Members; Steve Bean, Sam Crouch, Ronald Hancock and John Kapp. plus 4 representatives from Wolfe Auctions and Mr. Fewell Melton.

SPECIAL USE PERMIT:

Mayor Freeborn asked Council if they would like to grant them a Special Use Permit for the day. Before granting it, Steve Bean spoke on the Parking there, saying the Town had had complaints on previous ones, and also Officer Damron and Bean spoke on keeping the roads clean. Wolfe Auction agreeded to keep the roads clean and try to help with parking, Officer Damron also planned to work during the hours of the auction to keep things in order.

Kapp made a motion to approve the Special Use Permit for one day only, seconded by Bean, the motion carried. Wolfe Auction also applied for the Food Consession, Hancock made a motion to approve Underwood's Deli to sell food, this was seconded by Kapp, the motion carried.
